Press Release

November 25, 2011:

On November 11, 2011 at 1214am a sheriff's deputy stopped a vehicle near the intersection of Colesburg Rd and Hilton Rd for a traffic violation. The driver identified as Kyle Bolsinger 21 of Colesburg, exhibited signs of impairment. Field sobriety tests were administered and Bolsinger was subsequently placed under arrest for Operating While Intoxicated and transported to the Clayton County Jail where he was held pending an appearance before a magistrate. Bolsinger is charged with OWI 1st offense and Failure to Obey Stop Sign.

On November 19th 2011 at 1225am a sheriff's deputy conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at the intersection of 215th street and King Rd for failing to stop at the stop sign. The driver identified as Joshua Eubanks 23 of Monona was found to be operating the vehicle without a valid license. Eubanks driving privileges had been revoked for an OWI test failure. Eubanks was placed under arrest and transported to the Clayton County Jail where he was held pending an appearance before a magistrate.

On November 21, 2011 at 505pm a sheriff's deputy stopped a vehicle at the north city limits of Monona for a traffic offense. The driver, David Hey 70 of Galena Ill, exhibited signs of impairment. Field sobriety tests were administered and Hey was subsequently arrested for operating while intoxicated. Hey was transported to the Clayton County Jail where he was held pending an appearance before a magistrate. Hey is charged with OWI 1st offense, speeding, and driving on the Wrong Side of Two Way road.

On November 22, 2011 the Clayton County Sheriff's office received information that a person doing community service for the City of Garnavillo was intoxicated while performing the community service. A sheriff's deputy was able to make contact with the individual identified as Stanley Bernhard 52 of Garnavillo. Upon further investigation it was found that Bernhard was consuming alcoholic beverages and was subsequently placed under arrest for public intoxication. Bernhard was transported to the Clayton County Jail where he was held pending an appearance before a magistrate.
